



Sport and PE Grant

The Sport and PE Grant was introduced in 2012. In 2017 the grant was increased £16,000 and an additional payment of £10 per pupil.

Barnes Infant Academy is expected to receive £17,800.

In 2017-2018 the Academy plans to spend the grant on:

Item/project	Cost	Objective
Swimming Lessons (Year Two)	£2,475	Children to be taught using the British Gas ASA Learn to Swim Pathway to help promote safety in the water.
Football (Reception, Year One and Year Two)	£1,900	Children taught ball skills by SAFC Coach to improve coordination and gross motor skills
Yoga (Reception, Year One and Year Two)	£3,800	Children are taught yoga, which is an ancient form of exercise that focuses on strength, flexibility and breathing to boost physical and mental wellbeing.
Employment of PE Apprentice	£7,146	Additional support for children. Provision of a wider range of learning opportunities and activities, e.g. basketball skills. Shared planning and delivery of teaching objectives with CPD for staff.
Attendance at PE conference (March 2018)	£150	PE lead, Head Teacher, and PE apprentice. Supply cover required.
Sally Scott – GB British track and field athlete. Competed at 2014 common wealth games and won a bronze medal.	£480	Event in June 2018. Circuits with the children, assembly and opening of outdoor area.
Mighty Zulu Nation	£775	Focus on dance skills, agility and team work and response to Music. Part of Sport Relief week.
Access to wider outdoor space – outdoor and adventurous activities for children in EYFS.	£300	Strengthening and developing of co-ordination, agility, strength, stamina and characteristics of effective learning, e. g resilience and perseverance.
Self-evaluation process, audit of PE provision. Work towards awards and recognition of high quality PE	£450	Auditing of provision and action planning, leading to improvements. Supply cover required.
School Skipping Festival	£350	Equipment, materials and training leading to school skipping festival.
