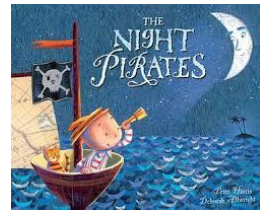
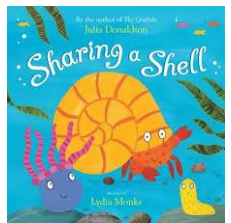
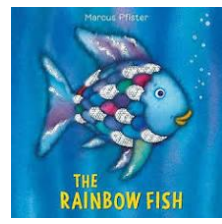
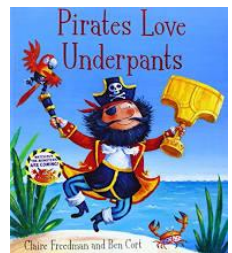
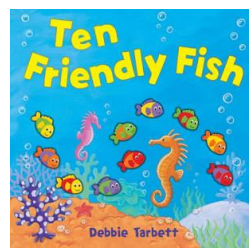
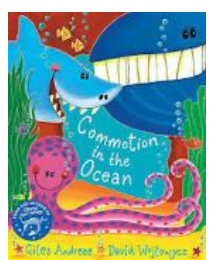
BETWEEN TWO RED AND YELLOW FLAGS
