To develop imagination when creating and developing possibilities.

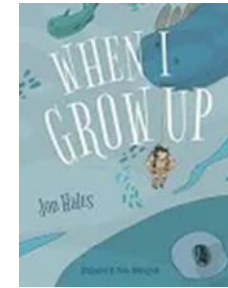
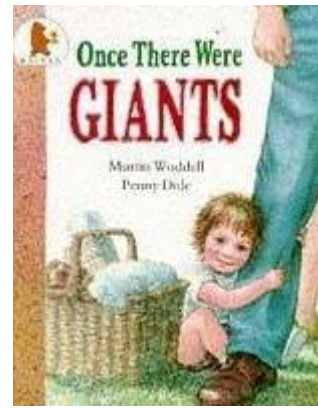
To explore a range of non fiction texts related to different occupations.
